**BCA'S LONGWOOD ART GALLERY @ HOSTOS** (450 Grand Concourse at 149th Street / 718-518-6728)

- **Graffiti: Spirit of an Age @ 40 x 10** – Curated by Ezo Wippler, this exhibition highlights works of 10 artists who began their careers in their teens making Graffiti art and have since have expanded their visual vernacular to include drawing, graphic design, painting and sculpture.

**ALEXANDER AVENUE ART & ANTIQUES DISTRICT**

**BRONX BLUE BEDROOM PROJECT** (309 Alexander Avenue #3A / 347-776-7504)

- **The Flight** – An Installation and Video by Fannie Allié in which a video of a window is projected on the actual windows of the bedroom. The video, adjacent to the installation of a sleeping figure on a bed, revolves around a character's interaction with his window.

- **Dreams** – An exhibition of sequence images, sounds and feelings from two emerging Korean artists Jina Son & Young Gi Han.

### DIRECTIONS TO HOSTOS COMMUNITY COLLEGE

- The Longwood Art Gallery @ Hostos is located at Hostos Community College, 450 Grand Concourse and 149th Street, at a busy intersection just steps from the subway station and bus stop. By subway, take the #2, 4 or 5 IRT trains to 149th Street and the Grand Concourse. By bus, take the BX1 or BX19 to 149th Street and the Grand Concourse. Travel time from mid-town Manhattan is usually 20 minutes.
- By car from Manhattan, take the FDR drive north to the Willis Avenue Bridge to the Major Deegan Expressway (87N). Proceed north to Exit 3. Take the right fork in the exit ramp to the Grand Concourse and proceed north to East 149th Street.
- From Queens, take the Tri-borough Bridge to the Major Deegan Expressway. Continue north to Exit 3. Take the right fork in the exit ramp to the Grand Concourse and proceed north to East 149th Street.
